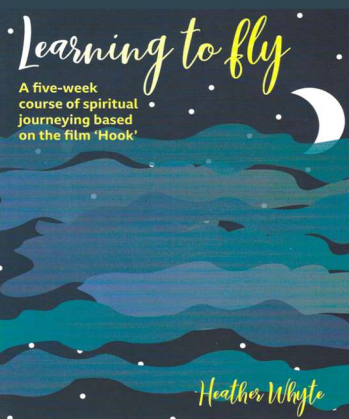


Emergency contact list
