# United Reformed Church Petts Wood

Dear Christ Church URC,

Well we are back in our second national lockdown. I think we all saw this coming (although maybe a bit sooner than expected). It is only 6 weeks since we have been back in the building but at least we are all set up for worship and community life online. The plan will be to continue worship on YouTube and Zoom services until lockdown is over.

We all need to play our part to bring the R down and to keep each other safe. It is a sacrifice to stop in person worship, but it is important that we work together. A lovely reminder of this from Kat last Sunday.

As before, please do be in touch with Kat, Fiona, your pastoral elder or myself if there is anything that you need during this time.

I have added a brief summary from our Moderator, Rev Bridget Banks. Her summary highlights some of the regulations that have resulted in our closure.

The guidance makes it quite clear that Places of Worship must close from Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> November

until Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December at the earliest. The only exceptions are for: Funerals To broadcast acts of worship Individual prayer Formal childcare or where part of a school Essential voluntary and public services, such as blood donation or food banks Other exempted activities such as some support groups

The guidance says that, under the new regulations, funerals can be attended by a maximum of 30 people, and it is advised that only close friends and family attend. Linked ceremonial events such as stone settings and ash scatterings can also continue with up to 15 people in attendance. Anyone working is not included. Social distancing should be maintained between people who do not live together or share a support bubble. Weddings, civil partnership ceremonies will not be permitted to take place except in exceptional circumstances.
